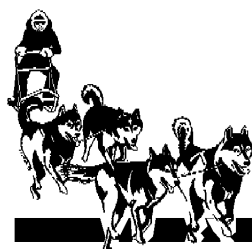

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY IMPORTANT- PLEASE READ

1. The CTSHC Race Committee reserves the right to refuse entry.
 2. The Organisers, Officials and CTSHC will not be held responsible for any personal (musher, dog or equipment) injury, damage or loss.
 3. Helmets are COMPULSORY in the Scooter/Bike classes (including single freight)
 4. Headlights and non flashing red tail lights are recommended for the Saturday afternoon Night Rig Race
 5. NZFSS rules will be strictly adhered to. These can be viewed on www.nzfss.org.nz (please familiarise yourself with the rules)
 6. CTSHC will not accept changes of class, dogs or mushers after the closing date except in the following circumstances:
 - A dog may be scratched if it has been injured.
 - A Musher may be substituted in the event of illness
 - If dropping an injured dog takes the team size below the minimum for the class entered, the musher may drop to the next class down.
 - Any changes to musher or team other than for illness or injury will be at the discretion of the Race Secretary
 - Please notify the Race Secretary immediately of changes – failure to do so may result in disqualification
- **There may be images or pictures taken during the race weekend. If you have any objections to yourself or your team/s images being used for any purposes please advise when submitting your entry form.**

Canicross and BikeJoring Rules

CANICROSS

A canicross one dog team consists of a competitor, racing solely on foot, and with one dog.

Classes

Competitions will be held in the following classes:

Canicross men and Canicross women for competitors from 16 years of age, younger participants may be accepted at the discretion of Central Territories Siberian Husky Club

Equipment

The dog shall be attached to the driver by a hip belt

The competitor shall not be wearing shoes that could be dangerous for dogs. Shoes with metal spikes are strictly forbidden. "Orienteering shoes" are acceptable.

Trail Rules

The competitor and the dog shall wait behind the starting line until the start signal has been given.

The driver shall not pace the dogs by running ahead of or force the dog to run in any way.

Pulling the dog or forcing the dog to move forward by any means is strictly forbidden.

If a dog becomes unfit or refuses to advance for any reason, the competitor is not permitted to finish the race

During the overtaking procedure the overtaken team shall make unimpeded way for the passing team.

BIKEJÖRING

A Bikejöring one dog team consists of a driver pedalling a bicycle and one dog.

Classes

Competitions will be held in the following classes:

Bikejöring senior men and Bikejöring senior women for competitors from 16 years of age younger participants may be accepted at the discretion of Central Territories Siberian Husky Club

Equipment

The dog shall be attached to the bicycle or to the driver by a snub line not to exceed 2.5 meters at rest in front of the bike. If the line is attached to the driver, it should be by a hip belt.

The bicycle shall be equipped with an efficient brake on each wheel.

All drivers must wear a helmet Wearing gloves is recommended.

Trail rules

The front wheel of the bicycle shall determine the starting point of the team and shall stay before the starting line until the start signal has been given.

The driver shall not pace the dog by driving ahead.

Pulling the dog or forcing the dog to move forward by any means is strictly forbidden.

If a dog becomes unfit or refuses to advance for any reason, the driver is not permitted to finish the heat.

During the overtaking procedure the overtaken team shall make unimpeded way for the passing team.
