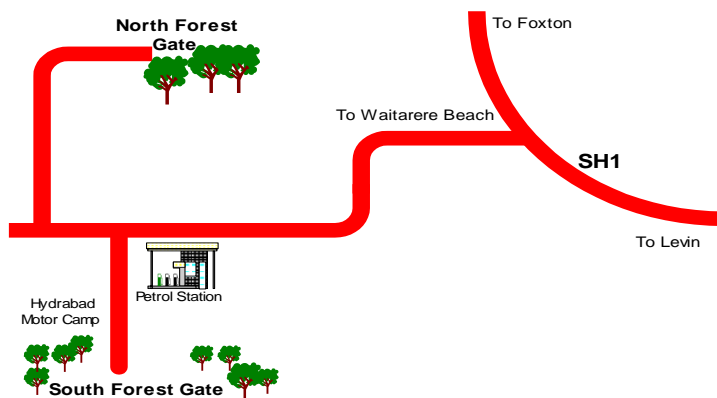


## DIRECTIONS
