General Information

Sled Dog Area

Logging at the Sled Dog area has significantly affected the network of trails, but, thanks to the dedication of club members and support of the Parks Division of ICC, the trails available this year will provide both variety and challenges for the participating teams.

General Trail Description

All the racing during the Scarper weekend will be run on loop trails from a common staging area, with Start and Finish within 100m of one another. The Finish line will be the same for all races.

The running surface in the open areas will generally be cut grass (bit lumpy in places) and bare patches of sand. In the forest section the running surface will be compacted pine needles on a sandy base. The terrain is essentially flat with a few undulating sections over old sand dunes. There are also some negative camber corners on the trail network.

There are sections of the trails that meander through pine forest and as a consequence there are some tight bends, and several places where the tree spacing narrows the trail. The forest sections are relatively short and passing may not be practical everywhere. This applies particularly to the larger teams. A program of trail widening is an ongoing process.

Common sense and good sportsmanship must prevail.

The SSSA Race Committee will confirm all courses prior to the Musers' Meeting taking into consideration track conditions, logging and weather. It should be noted that, even though the area is situated on a well-drained sandy base, during and immediately following heavy rain, there will be standing water along sections of the trails and probably a bit of mud too. There is also a chance of encountering the odd shallow wheel rut - rigs and scooters with a knobby front tyre will be the least affected.

Detailed trail conditions will be available at the compulsory Musers' Meeting.

Schedule of Events - Saturday

Saturday 2 June – Scarper Fest (non-sanctioned)

3.2km (late morning) Senior (Mens & Womens) Canicross 1 dog

2.2km (late morning) Junior (16 and under) Canicross 1 dog

This will be a **mass start** with Senior and Junior (16 and under) starting together. Both will be loop courses finishing at the CaniDen. The Junior course will shortcut the Senior course. Juniors may choose to enter the relevant Senior class if they wish.

3.2km (late morning) Bikejor 1 dog

The trail will be a loop track with the finish at the CaniDen.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

2.2km (late morning) Veteran Dog(s) (8 years +) 1 or 2 dog

The trail will be a loop track with the finish at the CaniDen.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

Saturday 2 June – Scarper I (sanctioning applied for - except Junior Classes)

1.7km (mid afternoon) Junior Beginner (non-sanctioned) 1 dog

This event will start off Scarper I. The trail will be a loop track with the finish at the CaniDen. An adult must accompany each musher around the course, and stay in contact with the musher to the finish.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

2.2km (mid afternoon) Junior Advanced (non-sanctioned) 1 dog

The trail will be a loop track with the finish at the CaniDen. Marshals will be positioned around the trail.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

3.4km (late afternoon) 2 dog Scooter

The trail will be a loop track with the finish at the CaniDen.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

3.4km (late afternoon) 1 dog Freight + 1 dog Scooter

This event will run over the same course as the previous (2 dog Scooter) class. Freight teams will be drawn first.
Start interval: 30 seconds.

5.0km (early evening) 2 dog Freight + 2 and 3 dog Rig

The start and finish sections of this course will be the same as the scooter classes. This event will be run at dusk so adequate lighting is mandatory. The trail will be marked with reflectorised markers. Freight teams will be drawn first.
Start interval: 1 minute.

5.0km (evening) 4 and 6 dog Rig

This event will run on the same course as previous rig classes and will begin 10 minutes after the last 2/3 dog team departs. It will be run after dark so adequate lighting is mandatory. The trail will be marked with reflectorised markers.
Start interval: 1 minute.

Schedule of Events - Sunday

Sunday 3 June – Scarper II (sanctioning applied for)

5.3km (early morning) 4 and 6 dog Rig

The trail for this class will be run on open generally flat terrain except for a few short, sharp ascents and descents that will require good control. Please note that there will also be a number of blind corners and sharp bends that may need to be taken at a controlled speed. The event will start in half-light so lighting may be necessary.

Start interval: 1 minute.

5.3km (morning) 2 dog Freight + 2 and 3 dog Rig

The trail for this class will be the same as the 6 and 4 dog rig class above and will begin 10 minutes after the last 4/6 dog team departs. Freight teams will be drawn first.

Start interval: 1 minute.

4.0km (mid-morning) 1 dog Freight + 1 dog Scooter

The course for this event is a shortened version of the above Rig course and contains similar elements. Freight teams will be drawn first.

Start interval: 30 seconds.

4.0km (mid to late morning) 2 dog Scooter

The course for this event is the same as the 1 dog Scooter class above.

Start interval: 30 seconds.

Sun 3 June – Scarper Finale (non-sanctioned)

2 x 2.1km (late morning) Canicross/Bikejor/Individual Medley/Team Medley Relay 1 dog

Both individuals and teams may enter this event. Individuals may choose to do one discipline (Canicross or Bikejor), or both. Teams will consist of one doing Canicross and one doing Bikejor. Canicross will start first as a mass start. Bikejor team mate can start when his/her Canicross team mate has crossed the finish line.

The changeover area will be between the Finish & Start lines. Individuals doing both disciplines will have their bike ready for their Bikejor in this area.

Other Individual Bikejor participants will be teamed up with a Canicross participant. This means that one Canicross participant may initiate the changeover of more than one Bikejor participant. This will only occur if there are more doing Bikejor than Canicross.

It is intended that the timekeeping will include split times so the results will show all participant and team times and placings.

The last finisher in this event will have the duty of switching off the Red Lantern at the prize giving to signify that everyone has been accounted for and that racing for the 2018 Sandy Point Scarper has concluded.

Please note: all course distances listed are approximate.

6:00pm	Scarper I 2 dog Freight, 2 & 3 dog Rig followed by 4 & 6 dog Rig (10 minute break between last 2/3 dog team and first 4/6 dog team). Start interval: 1 minute. Lights mandatory.
7:25pm	Supper. Venue: Scout Camp Common Room.
7:30pm	Scarper Fest & Scarper I results posted. Venue: Scout Camp Common Room.
8:00pm	Scarper Fest & Scarper I prizegiving followed by compulsory Musers' Meeting and bib draw for Scarper II sanctioned events.

Sunday 3 June

8:00am	Scarper II 4 & 6 dog Rig followed by 2 dog Freight, 2 & 3 dog Rig (10 minute break between last 4/6 dog team and first 2/3 dog team). Start interval: 1 minute. Lights may be required.
9:00am	Scarper II 1 dog Freight & 1 dog Scooter. Start interval: 30 seconds.
9:45am	Scarper II 2 dog Scooter. Start interval: 30 seconds.
10:30am	Scarper Finale Briefing. Venue: Oustide CaniDen.
10:45am	Scarper Finale. 1 dog Medley Relay/Canicross/Bikejor. Mass start (Canicross).
11:55am	Scarper II and Scarper Finale results posted. Venue: Scout Camp Common Room.
12:00pm	Brunch followed by Scarper II & Scarper Fest prizegiving. Venue: Scout Camp Common Room.

Please note:

**Times are approximate and, whilst we will endeavour to adhere to the timetable, there is a margin of error due to unforeseen circumstances.
If in doubt, check with the Head Timekeeper.**

Some Important Points

- As always, the Race Marshall's decision is final.
- As a consequence of our Safety Management Plan:
 - Safety helmets will be compulsory for all classes, except Canicross.
 - Neckline connecting double lead dogs is mandatory.
 - We discourage competitors from bagging dogs, particularly in bags that are not adequately ventilated. If a dog cannot continue racing, the musher must assess the condition of the dog to ensure the dog will not overheat in the rig bag. We recommend that you move the team to a safe position off the trail and wait until the dog has cooled down sufficiently to be safely carried in the rig bag, or wait to be picked up. We encourage mushers to carry water/bowl. If necessary, a recovery vehicle will be available to transport any dropped dog or team back to the staging area.
- Musher packs will be distributed to all mushers at the compulsory Mushers' Meetings on Saturday 2 June.
- It is recommended that you have an effective headlight as it can be dark in forested areas of the trails. Tail light and headlight are mandatory for Scarper I rig race.
- Class changes for sanctioned events, after entries have been accepted, must be accompanied by "just cause" and must be presented to the Race Marshall before the relevant Mushers' Meeting. The Race Marshall's decision will be final.
- All classes will only be run if there are three (3) or more entries received by the official closing date (25 May 2018). If there are insufficient entries for any given class, mushers who have entered for that class will be contacted regarding alternative options.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and are not allowed into any buildings at the race venue.
- Noise is not a factor - nearest neighbours are a long way off. However, there will be people who want a good night's sleep so please be considerate.
- All holes are to be filled in, and all dog mess disposed of appropriately; rubbish bins will be available.
- All dogs (whether racing or just staying at the Scout Camp) must have been immunised, and be free of infectious disease.
- Remember - never bring any dog that may have been exposed to a contagious disease to a race.
- It is the responsibility of the musher to ensure that all the dogs he/she will be racing are appropriately conditioned and in a fit state to complete the race(s), and to monitor the wellbeing of their dogs.
- It is envisaged that a competitor can enter a number of the sanctioned events provided they have sufficient dogs and/or the dogs are adequately conditioned for the workload. However, this will be at the competitor's own risk. There is no guarantee that the competitor will have enough time to complete one event, and get to the start in time for the next event. There is a risk that a competitor's bib draws for consecutive events will not allow enough time to make the following start time. If a team is not in the start chute in time for their start, it will be treated as a missed start under the rules.
- **Cancellations:** Any entry cancellation received a minimum of 5 days prior to the first event will be eligible for a full refund. Any cancellation received within the 5 days prior to the first event MAY be eligible for a partial refund upon assessment by the SSSA committee after the event. Please allow 14 days after the event for any refund to be processed.

Accommodation

As always, accommodation for the mushers is available at the 'dog friendly' Scout Camp at Sandy Point (see attached map for directions). This means that mushers (who stay at the camp) do not have to drive their dogs and their equipment to the race staging point, as the start and finish points for the Fosbender Park race course is based adjacent to the Scout Camp!

Dogs must not be taken into any building at the Scout Camp.

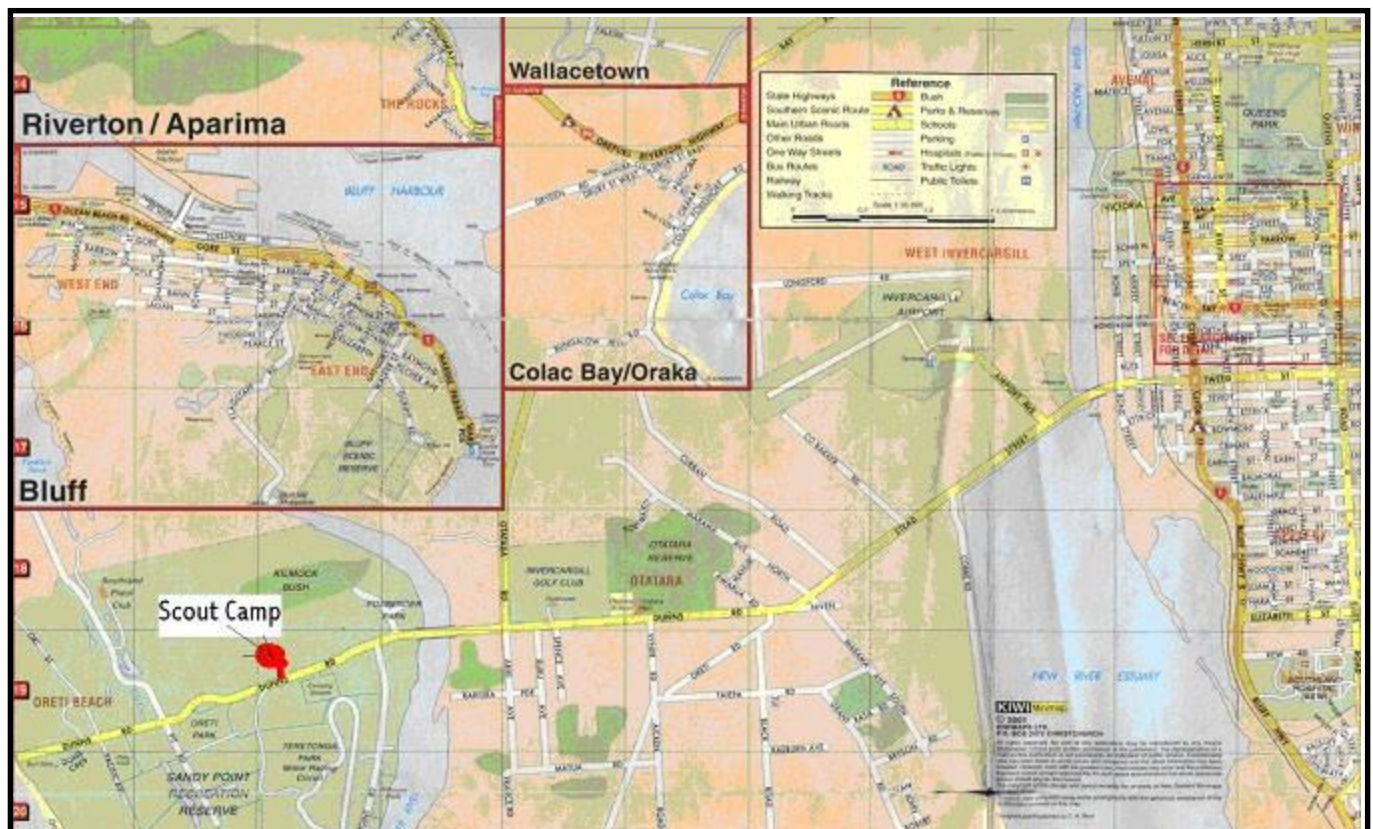
You need to provide your own sleeping bag/bedding, towels etc.

The Scout Camp is also suitable for tenting, caravans and motor-homes. Please note that you will still be required to pay the accommodation fee.

The Scout Camp will be open on Friday. A permanent directional sign is on the main board at the corner of Dunns Road and Sandy Point Road, and there is another sign at the turn off to the Scout Camp.
