RACE DETAILS

1 Dog Scooter, 2 Dog Scooter, Bike Jor & Open

R1 – 30sec Starts (bibs by order of entry)

R2 – 30sec Starts (Same Bib)

R3 – Mass Start (Same Bib)

Cani Cross

R1 – Mass Start (bibs by Order of entry)

R2 – Mass Start (Same Bib)

R3 – Mass Start (Same Bib)

Pee-wee

R2 – 15sec Starts (bibs by order of entry)

Race 1 – Levels raceway Carpark

Parking will be as you come in the entrance on the right hand side over by the tree line (map will be issued) the race will start from here and work its way along the hedge to the entry road then head down the seal road until you hit the gravel then onto grass. Stay on the grass around the edge before you head up onto the bank, follow the bank back around before heading down and into the sealed pit area. Follow the pit track out onto pit lane before coming back into the pits north of the tower building. Make your way past the clubrooms before heading back onto the bank continue along the bank to the finish line.

Race 2 - Pleasant Point Domain

Parking will be as soon as you enter the domain on the left hand side (map will be issued) Pee Wee will walk down the path and run back towards the carpark. Main race will start over the entry by the rocks and follow the gravel track around when you get to the final opening then follow the track to the seal heading to the left around the back of the rugby club rooms, continue along the track until the finish line. Note there is small judder bars along the seal

Race 3 – Levels Raceway Racetrack

Parking will be in the pit area we will be racing around the track starting just outside the pit exit gate on the grass. We will be racing on the grass beside the seal and following the grass edge around the track. If you choose you can run on the seal.





WEEKEND FORMAT

All classed will have three separate races over the weekend, except Pee-wee, each race will have its own race results but all race times will be added to have an overall weekend result.

Race 1 and 2 will be 30 second start intervals and race 3 will be a mass start. Race three is on a sealed track but we are using the grass on the outside. Please be aware of dog safety and your own dogs capabilities.

Race 1 and 3 are on private land but race 2 is on public land. We will be doing our best to prevent you coming across public but please be aware that you may encounter members of the public and their dogs. Please also be aware of private houses near the gate for Races 1 & 3.

10min gap between last musher finishing and the start of the next race

Race bibs will be issued as per your entry; you will keep the same number for the weekend for the race events you have entered

Any changes you will be advised before the weekend.

Scooter/Bikejor:

If you are wanting to do two of the same scooter or Bikejor then put one of your entries under the open class but we will put your time in the scooter or Bikejor results.

If classes are looking to be to big then we will split them down into two groups, this will be advised before the day.

Prizes:

To be eligible for prizes you must run with the same musher for all three races (sanctioned weight pull is included as one of your three). Prizes will be given out for the individual races and not the overall results for the weekend. All prize giving's will be held upstairs at the rugby club rooms at the Pleasant Point Domain

Weight pull:

Weight pull will run on Saturday 12th after racing has finished. If you are entering your dog into the competitive weigh pull competition, then you are not allowed to enter into Saturdays Mornings race. There will be a novice weight pull competition which you can still do the mornings race but there will be a max of 3 pulls only

Dinner:

Dinner will be catered for by Shirleys pantri on Saturday night plus soup and cheese rolls at Sunday's Prize giving

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All entry forms must be signed prior to the race start of racing, or you will not be permitted to compete.

- Class changes will only be permitted prior to 11am 11th September 2020 by notification to the race organiser. The only exception to this will be if a musher requires to drop down a class due to dog injury or illness and is at the discretion of RGO.
- Dogs must be on a leash or securely restrained at all times, at the race venues and headquarters.
- All dog poo is to be disposed of by owners, all holes to be filled in and all rubbish to be removed from race venues.
- Please do not bring any dog to this event that has been exposed to any contagious disease, particularly kennel cough.
- The RGO reserves the right to eject or cancel any entries for unsportsmanlike or unsporting like behaviours during the event, at our discretion.
- Neck lines **are compulsory** for double leaded dogs.
- Head lights may be required
- Helmets will be compulsory in all classes except for Cani Cross.
 Any musher without a helmet will not be permitted to race
- Sanctioned weigh pull will be classed as one of the three events for the weekend, please note it on this entry form but a separate entry form will be sent out for the weight pull event
