The Organisers and the Committee of the Northern Alaskan Malamute Club wish to advise that Sled Dog racing may be considered a hazardous activity and will not be held responsible for any personal (Musher, Dog or Equipment) injury damage or loss. We **strongly** recommend the use of safety equipment including, but not restricted to, eye protection and gloves. For the safety of dogs we accept that dogs can run in muzzles. **Helmets MUST** be worn on scooters and rigs at all times. **Hi-viz clothing MUST** be worn while on forestry trails. Headlights and rig lightening are recommended for any race, especially early morning and evening events.

Each musher must sign this declaration in order to validate their entry for this event. If the musher is under the age of 18 years the parent or guardian must sign on their behalf.

Signing this entry form will be taken as acceptance of terms and conditions for this event/ races and of NZFSS rules and regulations will be adhered to.

Entry will not be accepted if not signed or accompanied with the correct fees.

Results will be posted as soon as possible after all times/places have been checked and calculated by the time keepers.

All mushers and public attending the event must comply with all health & safety regulations outlined by NAMC.

Directions for Waiotapu Forest School Camp, Waikokomuku Road.

If you are heading south from Rotorua on SH5, the turn off (Old Waiotapu Road) is the first left after the Murupara turn off (SH38). If you are heading north from Taupo on SH5, the turn off (Old Waiotapu Road) is the first right after the Waiotapu Village and pub. There will be a sign up on the junction of SH5 and Old Waiotapu Road that is clearly visible in car headlights. Follow Old Waiotapu Road for 2km until you reach a locked gate (and tourist carpark). Please park to the side of the road and wait for the gate to be unlocked at the designated times. Vehicles will convoy from the gate to the camp.

ACCOMMODATION;

NAMC is offering camp accommodation, which is basic school camp style, there is power in cabins. If staying at the camp you will need to bring your own sleeping bag, blankets, towels and pillows. Please remember that it can get very **cold** at this time of the year, so if staying at the camp come prepared. There are toilets, hot showers, communal dining hall and a kitchen that is fully equipped. Tea, Coffee, milo and milk will be provided.

There are 12 x 6 man huts, 1x 2 man huts, and 10 x 1 man huts. Huts will be allocated on a 1st come basis.

ABSOLUTELY NO ELECTRIC HEATERS AS THIS WILL BLOW CAMP FUSE BOX.

Please remember all cabins are smoke free and no dogs permitted in cabins. No dogs permitted on grassed area at camp leading down to the stream.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO RESPECT THE CAMP RULES SO WE ALL CAN CONTINUE TO USE THIS AWESOME PLACE AGAIN AND AGAIN.

NO MEALS ARE PROVIDED BUT THE KITCHEN IS YOURS TO USE REMEMBER TO CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELVES.

Please remember to CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS there will be plenty of bins around the venue for you to use.
