RACE INFORMATION

Race Venue

The venue is an operating orchard at 56 Nicholl Road, Twyford, Hastings. All entrants and visitors will be signed in at the gate and COVID protocols complied with.

Men's and Women's toilets will be available on site. Tea/Coffee facilities available.

Due to this event being held in a working orchard there is to be no smoking, drugs or alcohol consumed at the race venue.



Classes

Two separately NZFSS sanctioned events – one on Saturday, one on Sunday.

Trail Description

Trail is flat with changing surfaces of grass, lime track and hard packed gravel and winds its way around the orchard on established tracks and through wide grassed rows of trees. Teams will need to have good commands to navigate the sharp twists and turns on this fun packed trail.

Start Intervals & Order For All Races:

Start Intervals: 1 minute for rig classes, 30 seconds for Scooter, Bikejor, Veterans, Juniors Start Order ; Freight teams out first in following order -2, 3, 4, 6 & 8 dog, followed by sprint teams in the following order 2, 3, 4, 6 & 8 dog.

NOTE: There will be a 10 minute gap between the last musher home in each class before the start of the next class.

In Signing this Entry you accept the following:

- Lights are compulsory for the rig class. We will be starting early to make the most of the cooler temperatures. This must include a forward facing light attached to the rig or musher and a red rear facing flashing light.
- ^e Helmets are compulsory for ALL classes except for canicross.
- This race his held under NZFSS race rules. You confirm that you have read and understand these.
- All dogs must be on a lead and under control at the race venue at all times. They are not allowed into any buildings on site. Dogs on tie out lines must not be left unattended. Please pick up all dog poo and litter and dispose of this off-site.
- [™] Refunding of entry fees is at the discretion of the RGO committee.
- The RGO will not tolerate non sportsmanlike behaviour; non-compliance of this may result in disqualification or future banning of the musher.
- ^e Dogs or mushers known to show behaviour detrimental to the sport may be banned from competing at the discretion of the RGO.
- ^e I acknowledge that if I have a junior musher participating, that they are capable of handing the dog team entered.
- The RGO will not be held responsible for any personal injury to anyone attending or competing in the event or for damage to any equipment/personal property brought to the event.
- I give the RGO permission to use any photographs or video footage taken at the event for use of promotion of the event in media and press releases. (Strike out if you do not give permission).
- We have a local rule approved by the NZFSS that if you are entering the 8 dog class you must have successfully completed two NZFSS sanctioned races in the 4 dog or above class previously.
- Class changes for sanctioned events, after entries have closed, must be accompanied by "just cause" and notified by 10.00am Friday 23rd July. These must be made to Sarah Campbell, pawtrax@xtra.co.nz or 021 1822 088.
- It is compulsory that all dogs at the event have a current Vaccination Certificate or Titre test and proof of kennel cough vaccination within the last 12 months. Copies must be provided with your Entry Form. Failure to provide these will result in your entry being declined and no refund provided.
- I will comply with any COVID-19 Alert Level protocols or restrictions that are in place at the time of the event including contact tracing requirements. I understand I am responsible for ensuring any person who attends the event with me also complies with these requirements.
