INFORMATION

COVID-19

The event will be held under government guidelines for outdoor events. NAMC reserves the right to change the event if needed to meet these guidelines. Please don't attend if you're feeling unwell or test positive for COVID-19 at the time of the event.

LOCATION

Racing will be held in the Kaingaroa Forest, based out of the Waiotapu Forest School Camp. Trails are forest tracks that vary in surface and are undulating. Please bring dog booties and your head/ rig lights, as they may be required. The distances may vary due to unforeseen circumstances and changes in the forest. Results will be posted as soon as possible after all times/places have been checked and calculated by the time keepers.

Directions for Waiotapu Forest School Camp: If you are heading south from Rotorua on SH5, the turn off (Old Waiotapu Road) is the first left after the Murupara turn off (SH38). If you are heading north from Taupo on SH5, the turn off (Old Waiotapu Road) is the first right after the Waiotapu Village and pub. There will be a sign up on the junction of SH5 and Old Waiotapu Road that is clearly visible in car headlights. Follow Old Waiotapu Road for 2km until you reach a locked gate (and tourist carpark). Please park to the side of the road and wait for the gate to be unlocked at the designated times. Vehicles will convoy from the gate to the camp.

GATES

This event is held behind locked gates, the club committee holds one set of keys. Gate opening times for arrival are detailed in the timetable. Opening times for leaving will be advised at mushers meetings and prize givings. If you miss gate openings call Yuki 021 2949 351, although cell coverage at camp is not great.

VENUE

There are toilets, hot showers, communal dining hall and a kitchen that is fully equipped. Tea, coffee, milo and milk will be provided. No dogs are permitted on the grassed area at camp leading down to the stream. Please remember to respect the camp rules so we can all continue to use this awesome place again and again. No meals are provided but the kitchen is yours to use, please remember to clean up after yourselves. **PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.** There will be plenty of bins around the venue for you to use.

ACCOMMODATION

The Waiotapu Forest School Camp has very basic bush style huts, with power and foam mattresses. If staying at the camp you will need to bring your own sleeping bag, blankets, towels and pillows. Please remember that it can get very **cold** at this time of the year, so if staying at the camp come prepared. All cabins are smoke free and no dogs are permitted in cabins. There is a combination of 6 person huts, 2 person huts and 1 person huts. Huts will be allocated on a 1st booked basis. You will be notified on arrival which hut is yours. **ABSOLUTELY NO ELECTRIC HEATERS IN THE HUTS AS THIS WILL BLOW THE CAMP FUSE BOX.**

The Organisers and Committee of the Northern Alaskan Malamute Club wish to advise that sled dog racing may be considered a hazardous activity and will not be held responsible for any personal (Musher, Dog or Equipment) injury, damage or loss.

We recommend the use of safety equipment including, but not restricted to, eye protection and gloves.

Hi-viz clothing MUST be worn while on forestry trails. Headlights and rig lighting are recommended for any race, especially early morning and evening events.

Helmets MUST be worn on scooters and rigs at all times.

All dogs must be under control at all times.

All people attending the event must comply with all reasonable rules and instructions from NZFSS, NAMC, Timberlands and Waiotapu Forest School Camp Trust.

NAMC reserves the right to use photos/videos taken at the event for (but not limited to) news articles and press releases.

Each musher must sign the entry form to validate their entry for this event and accept the event terms and conditions. If the musher is under the age of 18 years the parent or guardian must sign on their behalf.
