Racing will be held in the Kaingaroa Forest, 25km from Rotorua. off SH 5. Based out of Waiotapu Forest Camp NZFSS Sanctioning applied for.

Please note: The trails: Teams will need to be prepared for an undulating course. All trails use forest roads with a good surface. The distances & conditions may vary due to unforeseen circumstances and changes in the forest. Please bring your lights as they may be required for the Saturday afternoon and Sunday morning races.

The 1 & 2 dog Scooter classes will be run as separate events. Mushers can enter BOTH classes if they wish.

ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday 17 August 2022. No phone entries accepted. Late entries will be at the discretion of the Race Organiser.

"KEEP BRIGHT, STAY IN SIGHT" – All mushers are required to wear day/night reflective Hi-Vis vests in the forest. Alcohol, smoking or drug consumption are NOT permitted in the forest.

Accommodation is available in cabins (6 person, 2 person & 1 person) at Waiotapu Forest School Camp, and facilities are basic. Absolutely NO ELECTRIC HEATERS as they will blow the fuse box. Cabin allocation will be notified on arrival.

You will need to bring adequate sleeping bags, blankets and pillows. It can be extremely cold and may be wet at this time of year. Please come prepared.

<u>CAMPERVANS</u>. Please note the camp charges per person if staying on site (even if in tent/campervan etc) Please remember that ALL the buildings are SMOKE FREE and no dogs are permitted in the cabins, or on the grassed area in front of the camp leading down to the stream.

Please respect the rules of the camp and the camp residents – failure to do so may result in competitors being asked to leave. The kitchen is available for everyone's use. Be considerate towards others and clean up before leaving the building and dispose of rubbish and recycling in the bins provided.

Please pick up all dog poop – this is a condition of camp use and failure to do so could result in loss of camp use.

The introduction of an e-scooter/e-bike event is an endeavour to provide an activity for:

- 1. Mushers whose health/age precludes participation in the physically demanding sanctioned events.
- 2. Allows retired dogs who enjoy a run with their owners under no pressure to still participate at events.
- 3. Ribbons will not be presented but effort will be recognized.

The NZ Distance Club will also be holding their distance race this weekend based out of the camp, in conjunction with Fur Flyers. – Race of Orijen I & Race of Orijen II will be the first two stages for the Distance Club Event.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – Fur Flyers Race of Orijen 2022

The FFSDRC Race Committee reserves the right to refuse entry

The Organisers, Officials and FFSDRC will not be held responsible for any personal (musher, dog or equipment) injury, damage or loss.

Helmets are COMPULSORY in ALL Rig, Scooter, Bike classes.

Races will be run under NZFSS rules. These can be viewed on www.nzfss.org.nz

I/We agree to run under the NZFSS Rules governing the race and shall abide by any official decision made at the race. I/We agree to be responsible for my/our conduct, the conduct of dogs I/we have entered or are under my/our control.

FFSDRC may not accept changes of class, dogs or mushers after the closing date but may consider a change in the following circumstances:

- A dog may be scratched if it has been injured
- A musher may be substituted in the event of illness
- If dropping an injured dog takes the team size below the minimum for the class entered, the musher may be permitted to drop to the next class down
- Any changes to musher or team other than for illness or injury will be at the discretion of the Race Committee
 - Please notify the Race Organiser immediately of changes failure to do so may result in disqualification.

I/We certify that we are current financial members of an NZFSS recognised club or we have arranged temporary membership of Fur Flyers Sleddog Racing Club by payment of the additional entry fee levy. Fur Flyers Sleddog Racing Club advises that there may be videos and/or still pictures taken during the race

weekend by race officials and sponsors. If you have any objections to yourself or your team/s images being used in promotion of the club or sponsors please advise when submitting your entry form.

Refund Policy - at the discretion of FFSDRC, but generally:

- Withdrawing before close of entry full refund
- Withdraw after entries close and up to 48 hours prior to event: accommodation full refund and race entries 50% refund.
- Withdrawing within 48 hrs prior to event accommodation full refund and no refund for race entry

Alcohol, Smoking and drug consumption are NOT permitted in the forest.

All mushers and public attending the event must comply with all health and safety regulations outlined by FFSDRC.

Each competitor must sign this declaration in order to validate his or her entry. Signing of this entry form will be taken as acceptance of conditions laid down for these events. If the musher is under the age of 18 years the parent or guardian must sign it.

I also acknowledge that if I have a junior entrant participating that they are capable of handling the dog team entered and accept that the organisers, officials and FFSDRC will not be held responsible for any personal (musher/dog or equipment) injury or damage caused.

We will be following all the current MOH guidelines relevant to Covid 19 at the time of the event. Other measures may need to be implemented as required.
